Reminders

Mobile phones

Earrings

Children should wear studs for safety reasons.



Learning

The children are learning new routines, for example tidying up, rhyme time and story time. They are beginning to develop friendships and learning to share and take turns. We will be holding a parents evening shortly when we can discuss how your child has settled into Nursery life and what we feel their next steps should be.



Tip for parents

Make your own playdough at home.



It is a good way to learn about maths (measurements and counting), extend descriptive vocabulary

(squeeze, squelchy, roll, flat etc) and helps strengthen children's fingers in preparation for early writing.



Basic Recipe

2 cups of flour
2 cups of salt
1 cup of water
Tablespoon of oil
