This information tells you what your child will be learning this term in school. We really value your support and the help that you can give your child with their learning.

These are some of the things you can do:

Help your child to learn the spellings or words to read which are given to them every week

Practise forming upper case and lower case letters

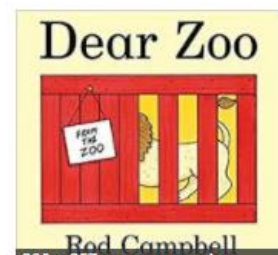
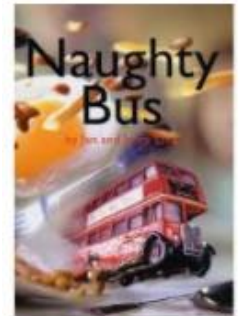
Read with your child every day for at least 10 minutes and come to *Everyone Reads* every Friday

Practise counting forwards and backwards to at least 20 starting at different numbers

The curriculum:

Our focus this term in English:

- Stories based on transport, e.g. The Naughty Bus, Mr Gumpy's Boat and The Way Back Home
- Texts based on animals, e.g. Dear Zoo, non-fiction information and poems
- Sequencing stories, describing characters, story language, e.g. Once upon a time....Happily ever after.
- We will be writing stories, information leaflets and poems



Some of the skills we will be focusing on in English this term are:

- Pencil grip
- Letter formation – writing capital letters correctly, sitting letters on the line in the correct place and distinguishing ascenders and descenders
- Continuing to use capital letters and full stops in sentences more consistently
- Spelling compound words, e.g. football
- Phonics for reading and writing
- Learning to discuss and share work with others



In Maths we will be learning to:

- Count reliably at least 50 objects and beyond.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract using a variety of equipment up to 20 and beyond
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving + - and =
- Measure length, height, weight and volume
- Problem solving with numbers to 50 by adding and subtracting
- Count in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s.

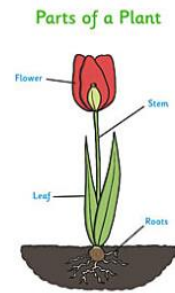


The 1st topic in the term is Transport and the 2nd is Animals

In **Science** we will be

- Grouping materials by their properties

- Identifying and naming common plants
- Looking at the structure of plants
- Observing seasonal changes (this will continue throughout the year)



In **PSHE** we will be

- Looking at how to stay safe on road and in car parks.
- How we can save and spend money. What money is used for and how it is kept in banks.

In **Art & DT** we will be

- Designing and making vehicles
- Making animal sculptures
- Using different brush strokes to create different effects

In **Geography** we will be

- Drawing simple maps using basic symbols
- Making maps and using directional language to navigate to different places
- Using basic compass directions when following a map

In **History** we will be:

- Looking at old and new transport



In **Music** we will be

- Learning about rhythm and beat
- Learning to recognise basic styles of blues music
- Performing songs

In **RE** we will be

- Looking at what different people believe in and how this helps them to lead their lives
- Looking at different religious symbols

In **Computing** we will be

- Creating, saving, retrieving and printing pictures using a simple paint package
- Coding and debugging algorithms
