Help your child to learn spellings and all times tables to 12x12

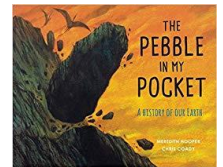
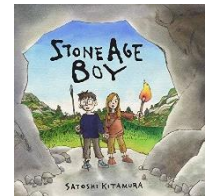
Read with your child everyday

The curriculum:

Our focus this term in English:

- Books we will be reading and using to develop our writing:
 - The Iron Man by Ted Hughes,
 - Stone Age boy by Satoshi Kitamura
 - The Pebble in my Pocket by Meredith Hooper.



- The children will be learning about character and setting description, finding and using descriptive phrases and they will plan and write their own stories.
- We will also be looking at instructions for games and using them to write our own instructions for the games we make in DT.

In Maths we will be learning to:

- Say what each digit's place value is in a 3 digit number.
- Read, write and order numbers with 3 digits i.e. Hundreds, tens and ones
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits mentally and using formal written methods of column addition and subtraction.
- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value and more complex addition and subtraction.



The topic in the 1st half of term is *Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age*

- In **History** we will be learning about changes in Britain and the world from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and the changes in how people lived throughout the Prehistoric Era.
- In **Geography** we will be locating the world's countries using maps, globes and atlases.
- In **Science** we will be learning about how fossils are formed, the rock cycle and different rock and soil properties.
- In **Art** we will be making clay pots based on pots from prehistoric times.
- In **RE**, we will be learning about Hinduism.
- In **Music** we will be learning to sing with expression.



- In **PSHCE** we will be learning about ours and others feelings and then will be learning that you can pay for goods in a range of ways and how to keep simple financial records.
- In **Spanish** we will be learning greetings, days of the week, months of the year and numbers up to 15.
- In **computing** we will be learning basic coding using scratch
- In **PE** we will be learning a range of ball skills such as passing and receiving



The topic in the 2nd half of term is *Let's Play!*

- In **Science** we will be learning about forces, including magnetism. Planning and carrying out fair tests, recording predictions, results and conclusions.
- In **DT** we will be using our knowledge of materials and magnets to create our own board games.
- In **Computing** we will be using a programme called 'scratch' to learn some basic coding.
- In **Music** we will be learning carols for our carol service in December.
- In **PSHCE** we will be learning about making choices on spending and saving.
- **Spanish and RE** will continue from the 1st half of term.
- In **PE** we will be learning to link actions and dance phrases to perform short dances
